THE UNIVERSITY OF THE THIRD AGE (U3A)

U3A is for retired or semi-retired members of the community. It is a not for profit, volunteer organisation providing educational, creative and leisure opportunities in a friendly environment.

Activities are provided for the people (members), by the people (Tutors). **Prior qualifications are not** required, nor are there exams or assessments.



U3A is not academic, nor sectarian, or political. We operate on the principles of self management and mutual support. In Australia, the first programs were offered in the mid 80s and currently national membership exceeds 100,000 with over 300 U3As. It is a worldwide movement, operating in Europe, UK, USA, South America and Asia.

WHAT IS THE THIRD AGE?

The "Third Age" follows the "First Age" of childhood and formal education and the "Second Age" of working life. It is the age of active retirement when you are free to link up with others and pursue your interests, without pressure.

ABOUT U3A BANYULE

Founded in 1986, **U3A Banyule** is a thriving community whose members embrace lifelong learning and positive ageing within a culture of respect and friendship. With approximately 700 members, we are the largest seniors' group in Banyule.

For a small annual membership fee, members can attend as many talks, courses and activities as they wish, subject to vacancies. (Note: some excursions or events may incur additional costs).

Our program offers more than 120 courses and activities per year, conducted over two semesters. Generally these are held during the week (daylight hours) and vary in duration: as single, multiple or year-long classes. Some activities are held on the weekend (eg lunches, theatre matinee sessions).

HOW AND WHEN TO JOIN U3A BANYULE
The annual membership fee is \$45 (in 2021) and
applies for the calendar year, January - December.
